

## **BUZZER Rounds**

8 teams with up to 8 players per team will compete in a Family Friend Feud competition by going headto-head with another team for 3 rounds for a total of 12 rounds.

Each round will start with two teams going head-to-head by selecting a player from each team to buzz in first.

\*You must wait until the emcee has completed reading the question or your team will receive a Strike "X"

If you buzz in first and get the correct answer your team will then have another chance to guess an answer. Team will then alternate guesses. Each correct answer gains your team points. An incorrect answer will result in a strike "X." After three strikes your team can no longer make guesses. Teams must alternate, as does the person providing the answer/guess.


Both teams keep the points they earned, if you strike out "XXX", you still retain the points, but can no longer answer. If both teams strike out the round is over and no more points can be earned.

## **BONUS Rounds**

The top 4 teams, those with the most points, will each participate in a bonus round.

For the Bonus Round, each team selects 2 players, one player will be taken out of the area and earmuffed as to not hear the other player. The other teammate will be asked 5 questions. The second teammate will then be asked the same questions, but must provide different answers. The team must get a combined score of at least 150 to keep the points earned in the bonus round otherwise they will receive none.

The team will the highest score wins! In the event of a tie another bonus or buzzer round maybe played.
